# Catholic Education Week

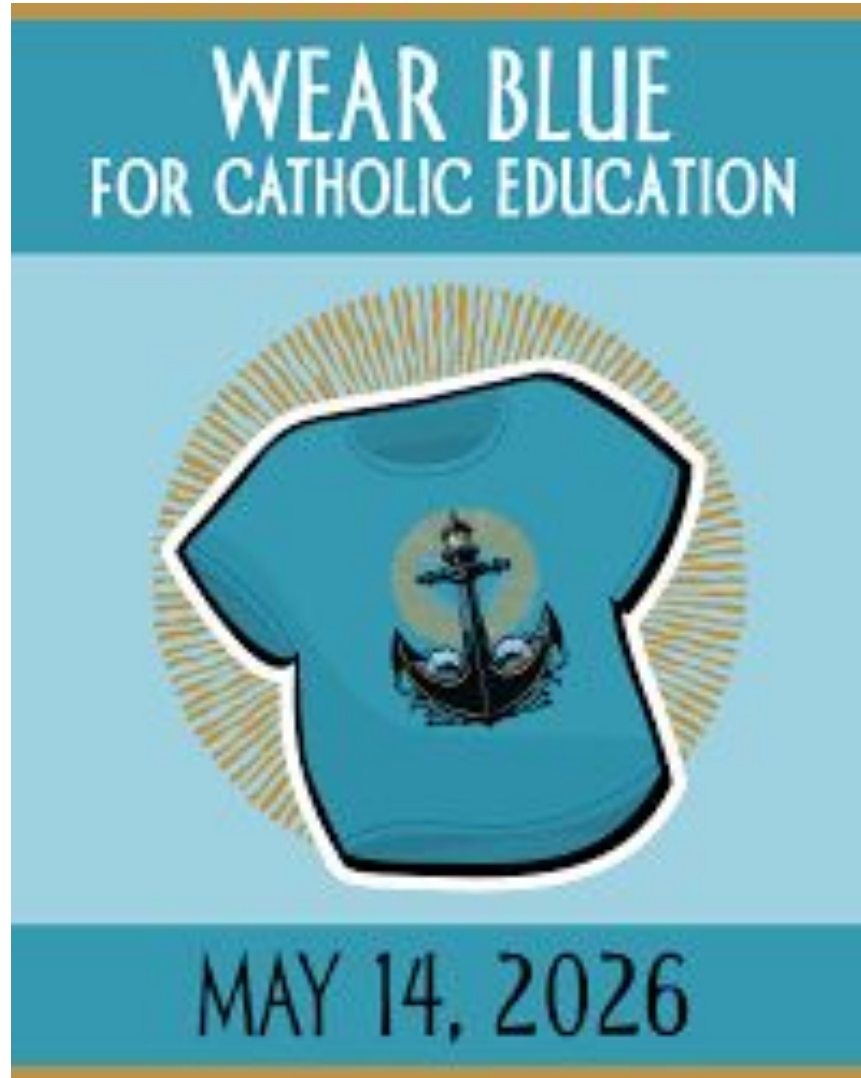
