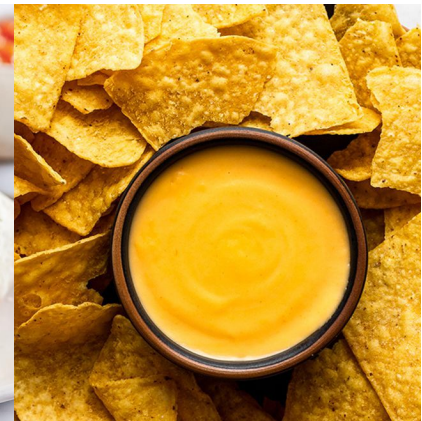

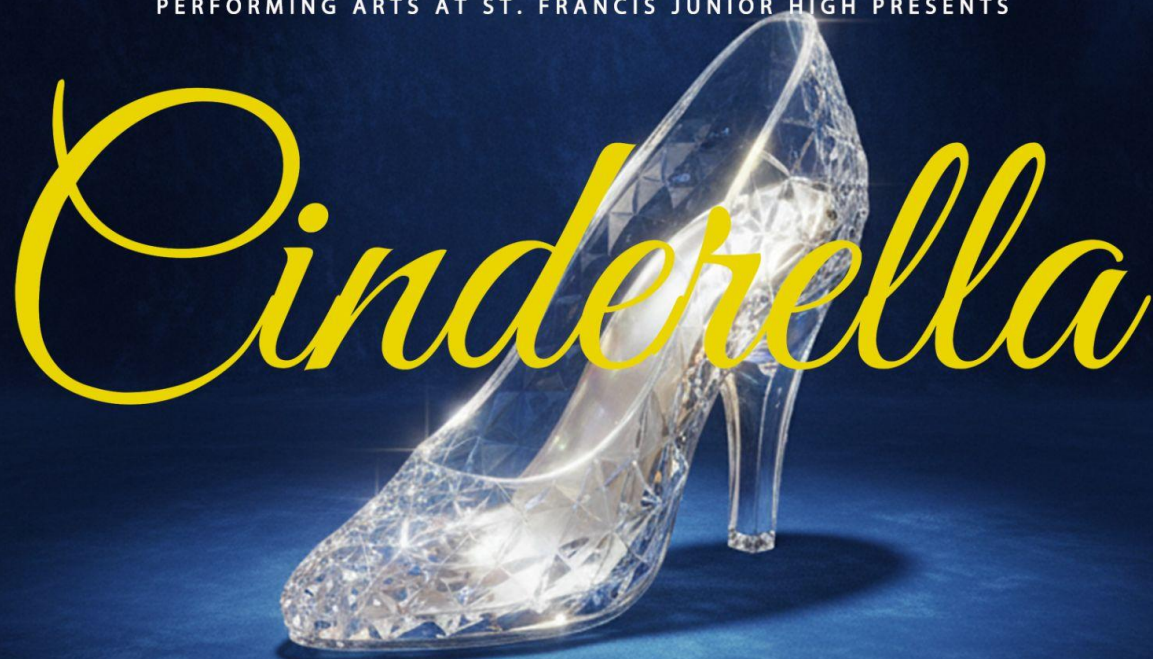

LIT SQUAD TWEEN BOOK CLUB

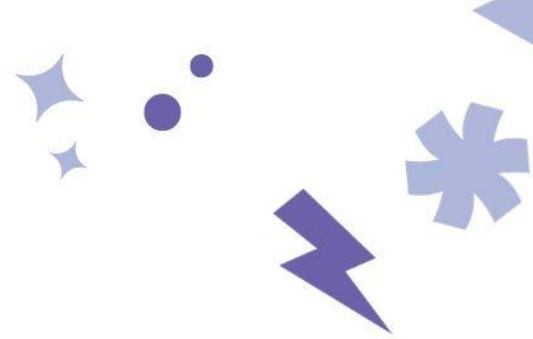
