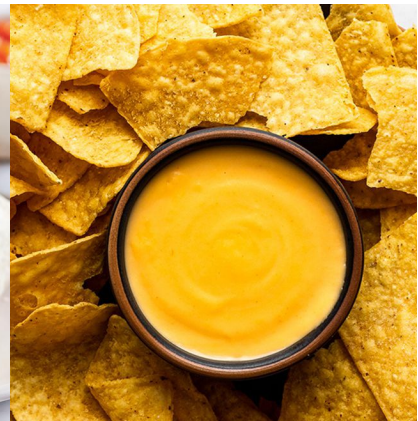


Canteen
