Luke 3: 10 - 18


Leader: A reading from the Holy Gospel according to Luke **Response:** Glory to you, O Lord. (Tracing a small cross on

Gospel Reading: Matthew 11:2-11

"Then will the eyes of the blind be opened, the ears of the deaf be cleared." — Isaiah 35:5


